#### GROWING SEASON

2022 saw a refresh of early rains and water, while a dry spring led to an early bud break. Harvest was generally about a week earlier in most places, but moderate temperatures and cool evenings preserved the acid while grapes developed to maturity.

### WINEMAKING

#### WINEMAKER

*Night hand-harvested grapes*

*Immediately pressed whole cluster, overnight tank settled*

*Fermented in barrel with native yeast*

*100% Native malolactic fermentation in barrels*

*Aged 14 months in 30% new french oak and 70% neutral, tired 1x every 10 days*

*Unfined and unfiltered*
